**ENTRY INFORMATION**

Entries close at 12:00 p.m., Thursday, April 05, 2023 Fees must accompany entries. All checks and money orders for Obedience and Rally Trials are to be made payable to Beartooth Agility Club of MT, in U.S. FUNDS, and mailed or hand carried to **Sharon Flemetis, Trial Secretary, 491 Countryman Creek Rd, Columbus, MT 59019**. No entry will be accepted, canceled, or substituted except as provided in Chapter 11, Sections 3-7, of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Facilities are NOT available for facsimile and/or credit card entries. Beartooth Agility Club of Montana will accept emailed entries with Venmo Payment or mail entries so that they arrive on or before closing.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. The club and/or its Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given by the owner or the owner's agent or for entering the dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT, PLEASE VERIFY PRELIMINARY CONFIRMATION.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are invalid.

Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees or a returned check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those that have checks returned for NSF will be on a cash only basis for all future trials.

Mixed Breed Entries. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

**REFUNDS**

**Bitches in season** are absolutely NOT ALLOWED anywhere on trial grounds-No Exceptions. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per entry per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

**No entry fees** will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

Refunds for cancellations due to judge change, overpayment of entries or cancellations made prior to closing date will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent after the trials.

**BACM** may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against BACM or official thereof.

### **TRANSFERS**

A transfer may be requested from the trial secretary if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers are to comply with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations.

### **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

Per AKC Rules and Regulations: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number, or AKC Canine Partners. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial-giving club is offering the optional mixed breed classes.
