This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the judge or veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

The request must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Chapter 1, Section 16A, obedience and Chapter 1, Section 16, rally.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Per AKC Rules and Regulations this trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registered breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number or AKC Canine Partners. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind are not eligible. Dogs that are deaf are now eligible to enter obedience and rally trials. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to enter. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Puppies 4 to 6 months old are now eligible to be on show grounds due to the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition. Mixed breeds that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

SHOE POLICY for the NEW TURF

No "special" shoes are required. However, no muddy, wet, dirty shoes allowed on the turf. This is why we suggest "turf only" shoes especially when it is muddy and wet outside.

Please make sure your "agility turf" shoes do not have a heavy tread as the new turf has way more traction than the old turf (our knees are not as young as they used to be for most of us!).

You do not need to remove or change your shoes as soon as you enter the building. The entry mats and black mats are down to collect most of the outside mud and dirt. We do ask that if your shoes are wet, have any mud, dirt or gravel on them, you change shoes before you go out on the new turf so mud and dirt is not tracked onto the turf.

During trials, overshoes/boots are highly recommended when you go outside to potty your dog(s) when it is snowy/muddy/wet. This suggestion is only to make it easier to change your shoes for you between runs with your dog.

Several facilities across the country have this policy. It is just new to us at YDS. It will take some getting used to for sure. This is just the best way I can think of to protect the turf so we can all enjoy it for many years to come.

One last thing; Please be sure and POTTY YOUR DOG BEFORE YOU ENTER THE COMPETITION RING! A \$10 "accident" fee will apply.
